5. Have your predictions about the love triangle on Mt. O changed after reading book 3?

6. Do you agree with Pan and Aphrodite that Cupid has finally performed his duty without a mistake?

7. What is your prediction for the future of Aphrodite's relationship with Q?

8. At the very end of book three, we know Cupid is gloomier than ever. What are your predictions about what is going to happen in book four, the last of the series? Where would you like to see each of the characters at the end of their stories?
