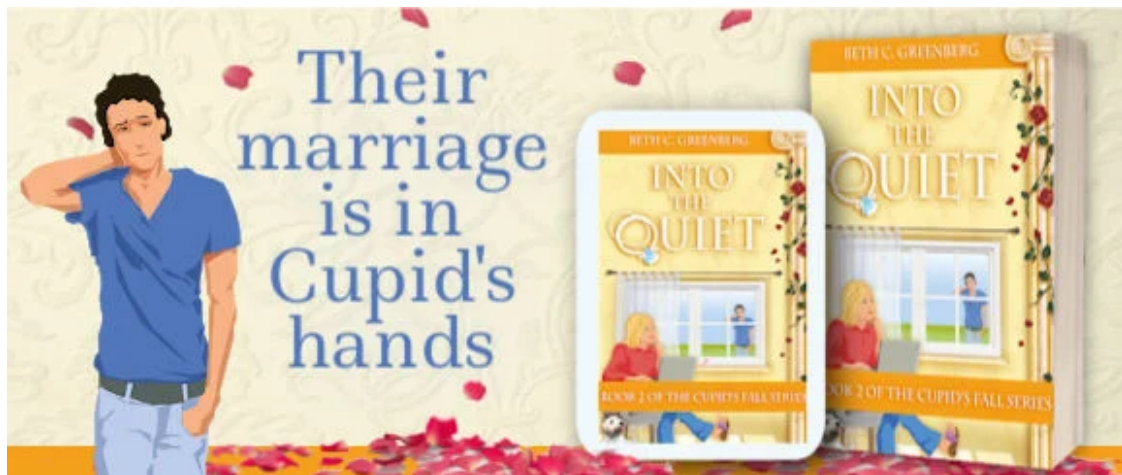

THE ORIGIN OF THE CORNUCOPIA

The subject of today's newsletter, "Cornucopia" (often translated as "abundance"), has its roots in Greek mythology. Where did the "horn of plenty" originate? As usual, mythology gives us conflicting stories.

ZEUS AND THE CORNUCOPIA

The most prevalent story about the origins of the Cornucopia comes from the time when the god Zeus was a mere baby. Rhea, Zeus's mother, hid her child away in a cave on Mount Ida on Crete to save the baby from being imprisoned by his father Cronus. There, Zeus was cared for by a nymph and nourished by a goat. One day while playing with an abundance of exuberance, baby Zeus broke off one of the goat's horns. The nymph then filled the horn with herbs and fruit, and offered the feast to Zeus. When the horn was empty, Zeus refilled it using his divine power and ensured that the horn would provide a never-ending supply of sustenance from then forward.

HERACLES AND THE CORNUCOPIA

A second myth about the creation of the Cornucopia appears during the adventures of the Greek hero Heracles (Hercules). Heracles was determined to win the princess Deianira, but she was also being pursued by the river god Achelous. The two gods agreed to wrestle for the princess's love. During the bout, Achelous transformed himself into a bull, at which point Heracles broke off

one of his horns. The daughters of Achelous consecrated the horn, endowing it with everlasting abundance.
