Here's a snapshot of books 1-4:

Book 1: First Quiver:

For the immortal virgin of Mount Olympus, Love is a game he can only play from the sidelines. When Cupid takes that game too far, he is banished by the gods and ordered to fix love. Cupid plunges to Earth and lands in present-day Tarra, Indiana, where mortals go on about their daily routines, oblivious to the gods above. At first, his sexy Earth-bod and newfound freedom feel more like gifts than punishment, but the gods have something terrible in store for Cupid—a taste of his own medicine.

Caught between two worlds on a quest to fix Love, Cupid must survive the violent throes of his own coming of age and triumph over the powerful gods conspiring against him. Failure will not be tolerated; success will cost him everything.

Book 2: Into the Quiet:

Cupid's punishment is far from over, and the stakes are higher than ever. When Aphrodite inflames her son's heart for Ruthie – a sweet, vulnerable, married Worthy – Cupid's divine duty sets him on a crash course with the matrimonial laws of mortals. And his problems don't end there.

Book 3: Quite the Pair:

For 2,000 years, Cupid has believed his best friend dead, but when the gods banish Cupid from Mount Olympus, he discovers Pan alive and well in Tarra, Indiana. Joyfully reunited, the two revive the camaraderie of their youth, but tensions mount when Aphrodite sets Cupid's heart signal on Pan. Failure to fulfill his divine duty will doom Cupid to suffer yet another tragic love, but to succeed, he must risk losing everyone he holds dear.

Book 4: The Quest for Psyche:

The God of Love is a mess. Unmoored after losing Pan to his Right Love, Cupid begs Aphrodite to inflict the next torment on his heart. When she refuses, Cupid resorts to a very human approach to relieving his misery – therapy.

His online sessions seem to be working until Dr. Mariposa Rey mysteriously cuts him off. Sensing she needs his help, Cupid sets out on a cross-country adventure to Lake Tahoe, where his heart is inflamed one last time. What Cupid doesn't know is that this fourth Worthy will be his one and only chance at Right Love.

With the ancient myth of Cupid and Psyche as his guide, Cupid attempts the impossible – a happily eternally after with his reluctant soul mate.
